Over 230 ENT Surgeries

for Children in Kenya



Critical ENT (Ear, Nose, and Throat) surgeries, conducted in partnership with the **United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR)**, are transforming the lives of refugee children at **Kenya's Dadaab refugee complex**. These procedures not only prevent life-threatening infections, chronic pain, and hearing loss but also restore children's ability to learn, communicate, and thrive within their communities. Cataract Surgeries

Restore Sight for Over 500 People



Cataract surgeries, simple yet profoundly life-changing, are restoring sight and hope for refugees at **Kenya's Dadaab camp** through our partnership with **UNHCR**. Although the impactful surgery is relatively inexpensive, it is still unaffordable for so many. As the leading cause of preventable blindness, cataracts rob individuals of their independence and quality of life when treatment is out of reach. Each surgery not only brings back the gift of sight but also transforms lives, reigniting possibilities and dignity for those in need. One procedure at a time, we are illuminating futures and proving that even the simplest acts of care can create a lasting impact and be a means of Sadaqah Jariyah for so many.

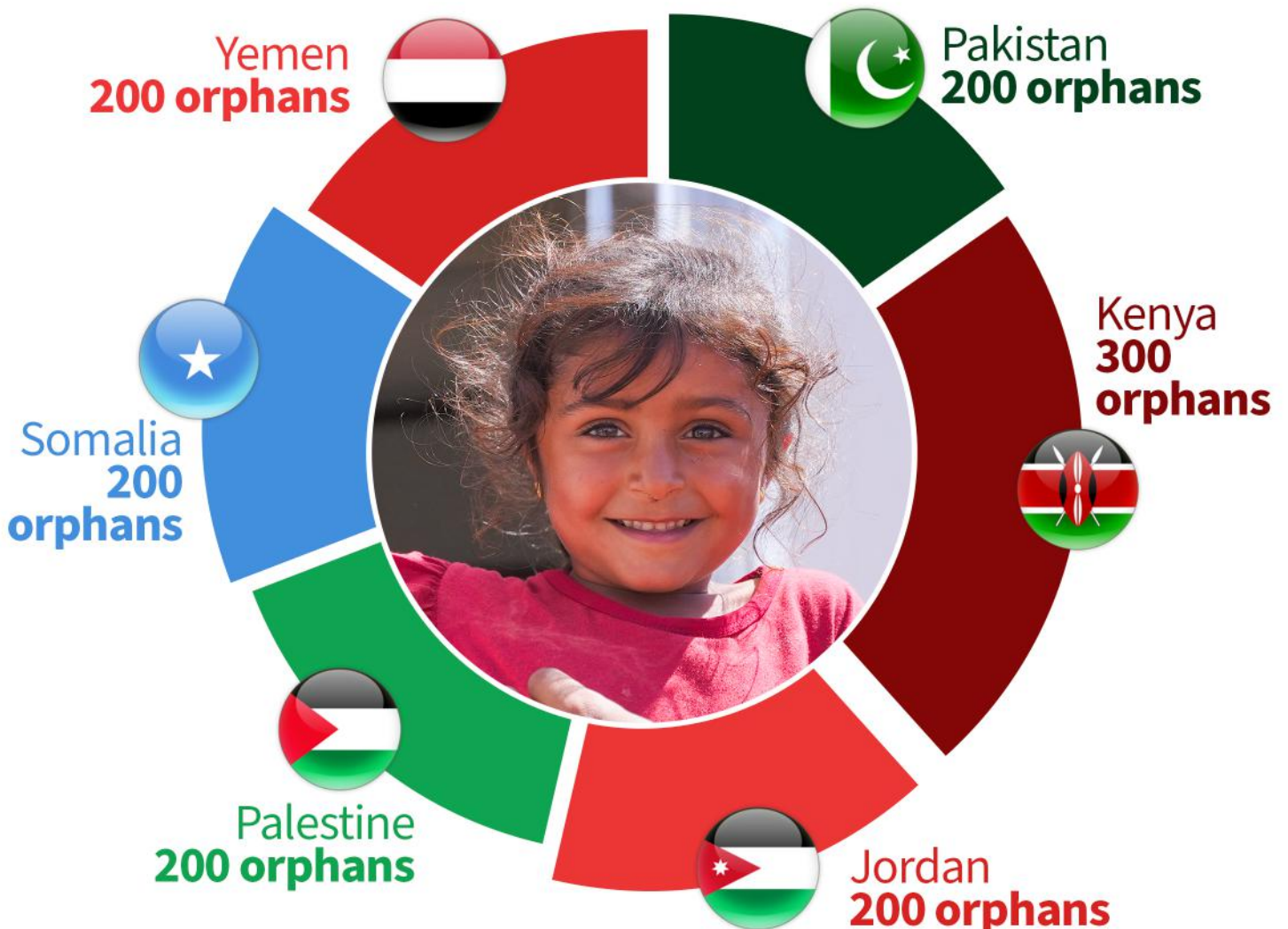

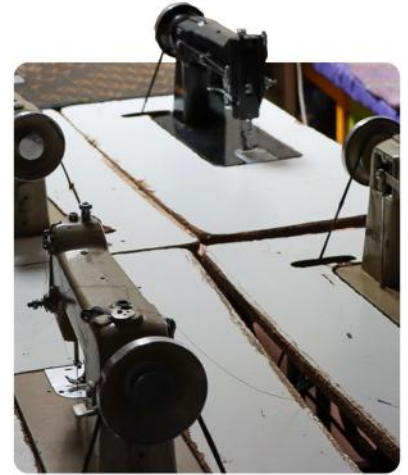
Seeds of Hope

Access to safe, clean water is essential for life, fostering health and serving as a vital lifeline for communities. Through our Water Distribution Project, we've built over **500 water wells and tanks**, bringing hope and transforming lives for those facing hardship. Our WASH Projects provided water and sanitation shelters to hundreds of beneficiaries daily, ensuring their dignity for hygiene needs.

Through our Winter Relief Program, **HDF provides life-saving, essential winterization kits to vulnerable families across Morocco, Yemen, Gaza, Pakistan, Lebanon, Bangladesh, Egypt, Sudan, Somalia, and Syrian refugee camps.** These kits—including blankets, warm clothing, and heating supplies—bring comfort, nourishment, shelter and hope to families with young children enduring harsh winter hardships during the most challenging months. Together, we're making a warm difference.

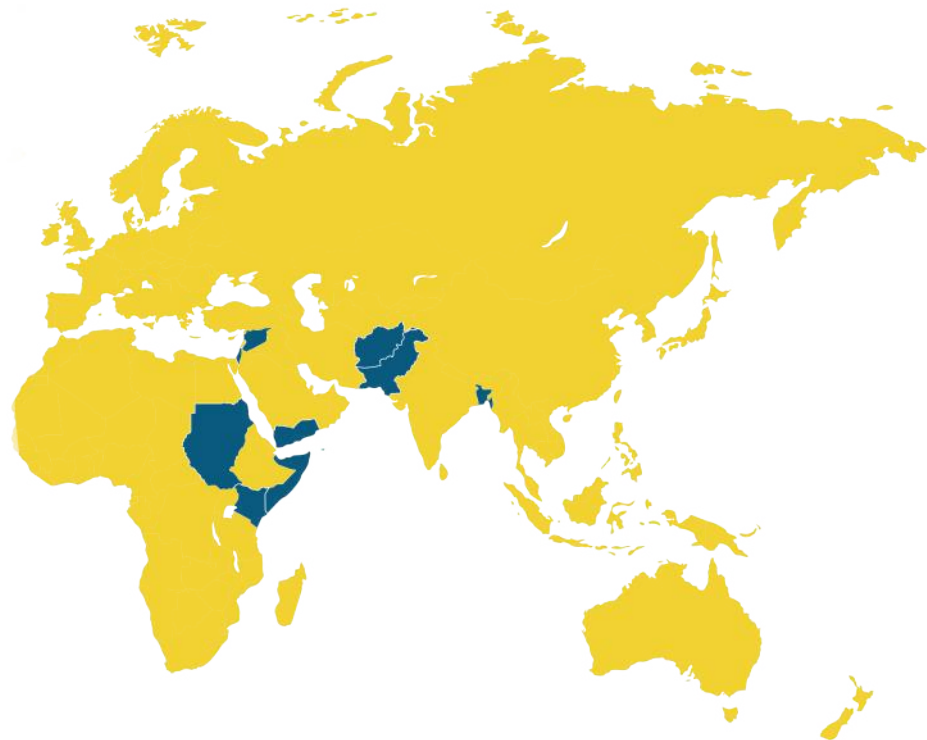

The Syrian Crisis has forced 6.8 million people to flee, seeking refuge in countries like Jordan, Lebanon, Turkey, Iraq, Egypt, and Europe, with only 300,000 returning home. Host nations continue to bear the weight of this humanitarian crisis.

Ongoing airstrikes, blockages and conflict in Gaza have caused devastating loss of life, life-threatening injuries and an overall widespread humanitarian crisis, creating an urgent need for food, clean water, medical care, and shelter to support affected communities.

HDF is committed to working closely with our on-the-ground team in Gaza to deliver timely, effective aid. **Our current response includes emergency food, water, and medical relief**, alongside long-term rehabilitation efforts to help rebuild lives and communities in the region.

ACCESSIBLE HUMANITARIAN AID

Yemen

(Internally Displaced People)



Yemen is facing one of the worst humanitarian crisis in the world, with nearly a decade in conflict, leaving the country in devastation. As a result, the country faces widespread displacement, severe food insecurity, and a collapsed healthcare system. **Compounding the obstacles, access to humanitarian aid is restricted and dangerous landmines are scattered throughout**, making it harder for families to reach water and receive the help they desperately need.

HDF is dedicated to providing life-saving assistance, focusing on supporting healthcare facilities with medical supplies and personnel, **distributing food to families facing hunger, ensuring children and youth have access to education, and rehabilitating water infrastructure to provide clean drinking water** to those affected.

Lebanon is grappling with a severe humanitarian and economic crisis, leaving millions of refugees and vulnerable families struggling to afford essentials like food. HDF has stepped in with an emergency relief campaign to provide food parcels to those in need. **These parcels are alleviating hunger, easing financial burdens, and restoring hope to families facing challenges.**

Heavy rains have caused devastating floods across Kenya since **March 2024, taking nearly 170 lives and displacing 185,000 people.** The disaster was further intensified by a dam burst in the Rift Valley, marking it as the deadliest of the season. Families have lost their homes and livelihoods, with rivers overflowing and flooding communities in Nairobi and beyond.

At HDF, we're committed to delivering urgent relief to flood victims. Our teams on the ground have been providing **food, clean water, and emergency shelter to support families** in need and help them recover from this natural disaster.

Heartfelt *Stories*

Huda's *Winter Blessing* A Story of Warmth & Hope



Winter is harsh for families in camps, where cold and illness make survival difficult. **Five-year-old Huda lives with her parents and five siblings**, and her father's worry about providing winter supplies weighed heavily on the family. Though young, Huda sensed his pain and prayed nightly for help.

Her prayers were answered when the Human Development Fund brought wool kits. With a bright smile, Huda said, **“This winter, I won't feel so cold like last year! Thank you, Human Development Fund. May Allah reward you for your kindness.”**



Nafisa's Hope for Her Family

A Story of Rekindling A Mother's Dream



For seven years, Nafisa Mohammed Hasan, an Egyptian mother, has dreamed of seeing her son Islam get married. Financial struggles and her health issues—cardiac disease, diabetes, and high blood pressure—have stood in the way. Still, she holds onto hope and the thought of future grandchildren.

Support from the Human Development Fund brought her relief with a food parcel, blanket, mattress, and meat. **“You’ve brought me hope,” she said. “To see Islam happy in his own home would mean the world to me.”**

Khader's *New Beginning*

A Story of Restoring Dignity



Fleeing Syria's war, Khader Owaied Althaher and his family faced freezing winters in a worn-out tent in Al-Mafraq, a Jordanian camp for refugees. The lack of privacy and resources weighed heavily, especially as his children grew older. His work, along with his eldest son's, barely covered food needs, leaving little hope for change.

That hope returned when the Human Development Fund gave them a caravan. **"For the first time in years, we have a proper shelter and privacy,"** Khader said.

Reem's Fight for Survival

A Story of Resilience and Security



Twelve-year-old Reem faced immense challenges caring for her sick mother and two younger brothers after losing her father. When bombings destroyed their home, they were forced to flee, living on the streets without food, clean water, or shelter. Her mother's kidney condition worsened in the harsh conditions, but Reem never stopped praying.

Her prayers were answered when the Human Development Fund provided clean water. Through tears, Reem hugged the staff and said, **“Thank you for saving my mother. Now we have hope again.”**



Bara'a's Story of Survival

A Story of Hope in Times of Darkness



Bara'a Ahmed, a mother from Gaza, has endured countless hardships alongside her children, fleeing their home multiple times in search of safety. Each displacement brought new struggles, **but the most terrifying moment came when an airstrike near Shohada' Al-Aqsa Hospital** set their tent ablaze. By the grace of Allah, they escaped with their lives, but they were left with nothing.

The Human Development Fund stepped in to provide them with a tent in HDF Camp, offering much-needed shelter and a sense of security. **“You gave us hope in our darkest times,” Bara'a said with gratitude. “In our darkest times, your compassion has been a lifeline for me and my children.”**
